

## SERVICE MANAGEMENT POLICY

OpenSistemas considers the establishment of a Service Management System (SMS), in accordance with the requirements of the **Norma UNE-ISO/IEC 20000-1:2018**, to ensure that the design, transition, provision and improvement of the services allow to meet the requirements of the services guaranteeing compliance with all applicable legal obligations.

Through the SMS, a process approach is established that allows the effective provision of our IT Support Service, whose principles are as follows, and which will support the objectives of service management:

- Understand and meet the service requirements to achieve customer satisfaction.
- Design and provide through the SMS, services that provide value to the client.
- Monitor, measure and review the behavior of the SMS and the services.
- Continuously improve the SMS and services using objective measurements.
- Align the SMS with the corporate objectives, the clients and other interested parties.
- Comply with all applicable legal, regulatory and regulatory requirements.
- Ensure the involvement and monitoring by the Management in the Management of Services.
- Integrate the objectives of the Management of the Services with the mission and objectives of OPENSISTEMAS.
- Train and raise awareness among staff regarding the management of services.
- Inform all employees of their duties, obligations and responsibilities in regard to the management of the service.
- Define and implement the figure of the SMS Responsible for the organization, which is responsible for managing the system and ensure the development, maintenance and improvement of it.
- Improve the SMS continuously and therefore, the management of services.
